Through certification, Junkers & Müllers is aiming to send a clear signal and help its customers beat a path through the **“green jungle”**. The Oeko-Tex Standard 100 has enabled textile manufacturers since 1992 to voluntarily test the human ecological characteristics of their products in order to obtain certification of compliance. The textile institutes are internationally recognized, independent and work to a uniform standard worldwide. In recent years, this has led the Oeko-Tex Standard to become the globally leading label for pollutant-tested textiles.
